Urayasu Robocare Center opens
~HAL FIT training is now available in Urayasu, Chiba~

CYBERDYNE, INC. (the “Company”), in coordination with the General Incorporated Association Japan Wheelchair Sports Association and the Company’s subsidiary Shonan Robocare Center Co., Ltd., will open the Urayasu Robocare Center in Urayasu, Chiba on December 3, 2018.

Similar to the other Robocare Centers, Urayasu Robocare Center will utilize the Company’s Robot Suit HAL, a device that is activated by the intended motion of its wearer, to offer the state-of-the-art HAL FIT fitness training program. The HAL FIT program is an advanced training program for visitors with disabilities or physical weaknesses.

The Company currently offers the HAL FIT program at 5 locations in Japan. Urayasu in the Chiba prefecture will become the 6th area to offer the HAL FIT program.

With the Opening of this facility in Urayasu, visitors who live in the Chiba area as well as visitors from the Tokyo metropolitan area will have greater accessibility to the HAL FIT program.
