Okayama Robocare Center opens

CYBERDYNE, INC. [President and CEO: Yoshiyuki Sankai, ("CYBERDYNE")] in coordination with Ibara Seiki Co., Ltd. [President and CEO: Kazuhiko Ueno ("Ibara Seiki")] and the Company's subsidiary Suzuka Robocare Center, announced to open the Okayama Robocare Center in Kurashiki, Okayama in May 2019.

Similar to the other Robocare Centers, Okayama Robocare Center will utilize CYBERDYNE's Robot Suit HAL, a device that is activated by the intended motion of its wearer, to offer the state-of-the-art HAL FIT training program. The HAL FIT program is an advanced training program for visitors with disabilities or physical weaknesses. Okayama Robocare Center will become the 7th Robocare Center to offer this advanced training program.

Opening of Okayama Robocare Center will improve access from residence of Okayama prefecture as well as residence of Chugoku, Kinki and Shikoku regions.

* Ibara Seiki Co., Ltd. mainly works on manufacturing of automotive parts and parts for agricultural goods and devices. The company has 4 factories in Japan as well as a factory in China and Indonesia. The Ibara Seiki group has a workforce of 800 people and the companies major clients are Mitsubishi Motors Corporation, JTEKT CORPORATION and Kubota Corporation.
