

Sendai Robocare Center opens

CYBERDYNE, INC. [President and CEO: Yoshiyuki Sankai, (“CYBERDYNE”)] in coordination with VITAL-NET, INC. [President and CEO: Takeshi Ichijo, (“VITAL-NET”)] and the CYBERDYNE’s subsidiary Shonan Robocare Center, announced to open Sendai Robocare Center in Sendai, Miyagi on May 25, 2019.

Similar to the other Robocare Centers, Sendai Robocare Center will utilize CYBERDYNE’s Robot Suit HAL, a device that is activated by the intended motion of its wearer, to offer the state-of-the-art HAL FIT training program. The HAL FIT program is an advanced training program for visitors with disabilities or physical weaknesses. Sendai Robocare Center will become the 8th Robocare Center to offer this advanced training program. Opening of Sendai Robocare Center will improve access from residence of Miyagi prefecture as well as residence of Tohoku and Hokkaido regions.

*VITAL-NET acts as a sales agent of CYBERDYNE’s HAL systems. The company mainly works on wholesale of prescription drugs, medical devices, reagents and non-prescription drugs. VITAL-NET has a strong network in Tohoku region as well as Niigata, but it also has an office in Kanto. In total, VITAL-NET has 62 offices and branches including the headquarters. The company has 2243 employees. VITAL-NET also has a subsidiary called VITAL-CARE, Inc., which offers long-term care services.
